Tyler's Take

We all know a person who is plagued by the disease of "Pride." A person that thinks more of themselves than they should and who are not afraid to let anyone and everyone know just how wonderful, talented and amazing they are. These individuals are not much fun to be around at the family dinner table, they are hard to share space with in the workplace and these folks are not the most popular people to share a row with on an airplane. This is because prideful people love to not only make themselves seem much greater than THEY are, but they also take pleasure in making themselves seem better than YOU are.

Pride is in this sense a narcissistic competition amongst those who have to feel as though they are the best at everything and need everyone to know it all the time. This illness of the soul is not only harmful to the prideful individual; it is also harmful to those around them... Beyond being clearly annoying. Pride harms the prideful because it flies in the face of the humble person that God desires us to be, thinking of ourselves in a grander way than others, thereby believing ourselves to be greater than someone else. We cannot be the person of Christian humility and kindness and also be the person who covets attention and does so at the expense of others.

The negative effects of pride extend beyond that to the people within the sphere of influence of the prideful person. Those around the person full of pride, feel the negativity of it when they are made to feel less than, when they are treated as though they do not matter and when they do not receive the level of respect that all people deserve. Pride therefore has harmful ramifications for individuals and groups alike when we allow our personal feelings of grandiosity to negatively influence others by causing them to feel inferior.

The treatment for pride is the desire to seek the life and demeanor of Jesus Christ as a model for our own life. When we seek to be like Jesus, we seek to be humble, caring and considerate to all people. Perhaps most importantly of all, when we seek the nature of Christ in defiance of pride, we strive to see ourselves as no better than anyone else and understand clearly than no one else is better than us. As C.S. Lewis says, "It is not that we think less of ourselves, it is that we think of ourselves less." That is the cure for the plague of pride: the humble love of Jesus.
